
The whole football squad has been outstanding, demonstrating our school values and brilliant sportsmanship in all their matches. Well done to everyone!"

# Taking Photographs and Videos of children during school events

It has come to my attention that unfortunately there are a few parents who are choosing not to follow our school policy about taking photographs and videos of children during school events and are posting images/recordings of children on Facebook. I understand there have been some attempts to blur out children's faces in these photographs and videos, however some of these children are still recognisable and parents/carers do not want these posted on Facebook without their permission. It really saddens me that, despite all the requests and reminders at all school events that parents are invited to, a small minority are choosing to ignore the school. I appreciate that you will all want to create memories of your children's time at school and I want to support you all in doing this – I know my mum has still got photographs of me in a Nativity play! However, I have a duty of care to all the children in the school and if I feel that any children are being placed at risk by images being posted on Facebook, I may have to make the difficult decision to not allow school events to be filmed or photographed by parents. Other schools, both locally and nationally, have a no image policy and this is not something I want to do as it would be penalising the vast majority of parents who support and respect Meridian school policy.

There are many reasons why schools all around the country request that no children's images are not posted on social media. Here are a few examples:

- Incidents of strangers approaching children and knowing their name and which school they attend because they have seen images of children in their school uniform on Facebook and were able to trace their name through parents' posts
- Children in foster care whose identity and location needs protecting
- Children who have been adopted whose location needs protecting
- Families who have been placed in a refuge due to ongoing abuse whose location needs protecting
- Parents who simply don't wish their children to have a digital footprint

Our Policy for the Use of Images of children is available on our school website. After Christmas, I will be sending out our policy agreement for parents to read and sign again.

If you see any images of school events on Facebook that have your child in without your permission you can either approach the person directly to ask them to take it down or you can contact the school and we will ask.

I would like to thank all the many, many parents/carers who support us in keeping the children safe at Meridian by not posting images on Facebook or any other social media site. I will do everything I can to ensure that you can create these wonderful memories, but I do hope you understand the school's position on keeping the children safe.

#### **Pantomime**

We rounded off the term with a fantastic theatre group and their performance of Treasure Island. The children loved it and were joining in with all the booing, cheering and shouts of "behind you!"

It was lovely to see everyone (children and adults!) enjoying themselves so much on the last day of term.
