Happy New Year! I hope you had a lovely break at Christmas. It was lovely to see all the children back last week all keen and enthusiastic to get on with their learning.

#### School closures due to snow

A few parents have been asking me about how/when decisions are made to close the school if it snows. The main decision is about whether it is possible/safe enough for staff to travel into school. If the roads are safe and there are buses running, then we usually try to keep the school open. However if the roads are not safe and there are no buses running, then we have to close the school. In terms of when the decision is made, this really does depend on actual snow fall and weather predictions. Usually decisions are made as early in the morning as possible so that parents can be informed, however there are occasions when the school has to close early in the day if heavy snow starts to fall and there is a risk that staff will not be able to get home. Once a decision to close the school has been made there are several ways that you will be informed: the school website will be updated; announcements on Southern FM and BBC Sussex; posts on Facebook; twitter feed; text messages – so please make sure we have your up to date mobile number. I hope this helps you understand the process and how every Headteacher in Peacehaven will have to make a decision based on their own individual situations/circumstances.
