

Times Table Rock Stars

This continues to be a huge hit with the children and their progress and fluency in knowing their times tables is growing faster than we ever imagined. Please see our top 4 tips below for supporting your child at home.



- Read the times tables aloud; say them together, then your child just on their own, finally say them without reading them.
- Scatter tables; call out a question. Focus on your child getting the right answer not just speed.
- Write tables on a piece of paper; doesn't have to be paper, could be in the sand, on the fridge or in the air.
- Play online; the key is little and often. 5 minutes every night, every week! ☺
