Wonderful Writing

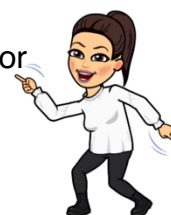
When we speak we often use short forms of words. I don't like pizza- I do not like pizza. Notice do and not have been 'pushed' together and the letter 'o' in not has been left out. We use an apostrophe (') to show the missing letter. When we leave letters 'out' this is called a contraction. Contract means to make something smaller.

- c) Someone to come to the door

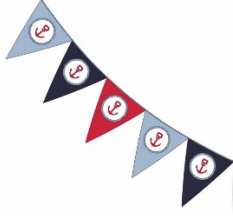
