Year 2

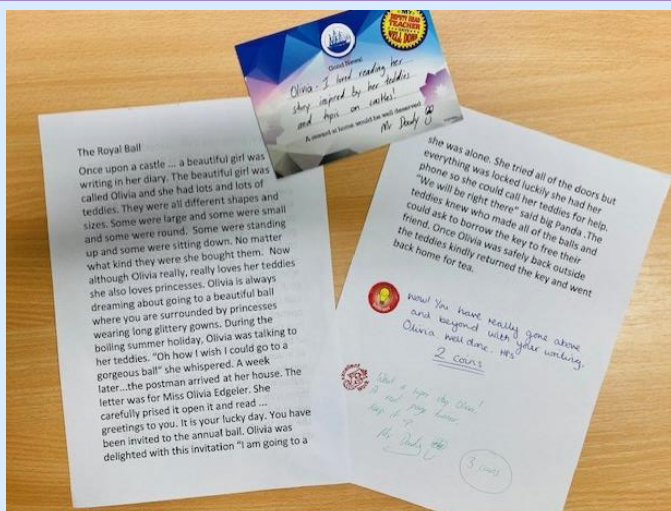
2P: Poppie is a reading superstar! She has made amazing progress in reading and moved up 3 book bands since September! Well done Poppie!
